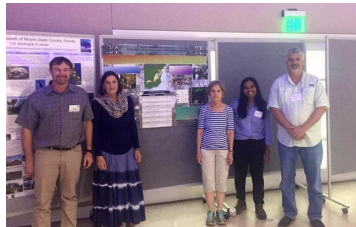


Recent Conferences
